

Why become a consignor?

You price your own items, and receive 70% of the price at which each item sells. The Faith Circle retains 30% of the selling price, with all proceeds supporting various mission and outreach programs. Consignors must register by Friday, August 27th.

Minimums and Items to Consign

Consignors need a minimum of 20 items or \$100 total sales. (For example – 1 crib priced at \$100 would be acceptable.)

What items can I consign?

- Clothing – seasonally appropriate (Fall, Winter, and special occasion) clothing for kids/teens that has been cleaned and attached securely to hangers. Make sure to securely attach 2 or 3-piece outfits together, and label them as such. **Be sure to organize your items by gender and size for easier drop-off.**
- Shoes – secured together. We will accept a max of 10 pairs per consignor.
- Toys – clean, and in good working condition with **all needed pieces**. Make sure that items needing batteries include **working batteries** for the sale. We do not sell non-working items! Use rubber bands or tape to secure boxes with small items. Attach price card **securely!** Limit of 5 stuffed animals per consignor.
- Furniture for kids/teens & baby items – clean furniture and equipment of any kind in good, working condition. Accessories – use sealable plastic baggies when selling multiple small items together, for puzzle pieces and game pieces.

**To help prevent theft, make sure clothing is secured to hangers (additional safety pins are a great option.) Name brands and higher-priced items are more vulnerable. Help us keep theft down.

How do I become a consignor?

1. You may download your registration form from our website www.humcfaitcircle.org or stop by the church office (M-F 9am-5pm) for a Consignor Packet. Mail your form, self-addressed stamped envelope and fee immediately!
2. Prepare items for sale by cleaning, ironing, hanging and pricing the items. We will not accept items in poor condition; anything that is not in very good to excellent condition should be labeled accordingly.
3. Download and print out our **new tags** to price your items. (You can download our tags from www.humcfaitcircle.org, or copy them from the sample located in the Consignor Packet). Attach all tags with safety pins or tape. (**No straight pins or staples!**) Use correct sizing when describing the item (no small, med., large, etc.). Secure price card in the upper right corner of clothing, with the hanger top facing left, as shown. Items in sealable plastic bags must have the price card affixed to the **OUTSIDE** of the bag. SUGGESTION: You may consider using heavier paper for more durable tags!

All tags must be full-sized!



****Please use BLUE or BLACK ink ONLY****

4. Indicate on the tag if you want your item to go half-price during our half-price sale. (**Any item not checked will go half-price.**)
5. Price your items fairly for their condition, **and use dollar and half-dollar increments (i.e. \$4.00 or \$4.50; not \$4.25).** Minimum price: **\$1.00**. Drop-off items at your appointed time. See the registration form regarding drop off times.

What does a Volunteer do at the sale?

Our volunteers are **VITAL** to our sales. They help us patrol during the sale, assist customers with questions, and perform various other needed functions. The registration fee will be refunded for consignors who work a **two hour** volunteer shift, and volunteers can bring a guest, and shop before the public! (Please note: We count on our volunteers. Volunteers not showing up to work an agreed upon shift will only retain 50% of the selling price of their items.)

Registration Fee

Consignors – the **non-refundable registration fee** of \$5 must be included with your registration form.

Pick up of unsold items

Items **must** be picked up between 2:00 and 2:30 on the sale date. **NEW: Items remaining after 3:00 will be sorted and donated as appropriate, and the consignor will be charged a \$25 fee for this service.**

***Proceed checks will be mailed within 2-3 weeks of the sale, so do not forget to turn in your self-addressed, stamp envelope. If we do not receive one from you there will be a \$1 fee deducted from your proceed check.

Please note: We are not responsible for items that are damaged, stolen, or separated from some of their parts. MANY people (children included) will be looking at/handling your item, so please keep that in mind when preparing items for sale.

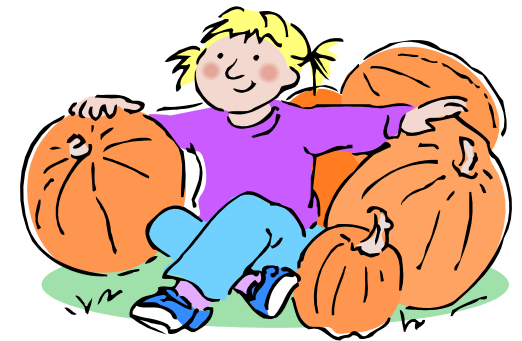
